**FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION:** In the 1930s, Pope Pius XI realized that Europe's royal kingdoms would soon become the stuff of fairy tales. However the pope was convinced that the new rulers of such kingdoms as Nazism, socialism and communism would not save people because these modern kingdoms would also lord it over their subjects and rob them of their freedom as daughters and sons of God. Pius XI wanted to challenge these new emerging kingdoms. He wanted to lead people to the one true throne. And so he proclaimed the Feast of Christ the King. We may be inclined to think that a feast that emerged from a specific political context may not be a relevant feast for us to celebrate. Sadly only recently Pope Francis expressed his concern regarding the rise of a disturbing nationalism. The pope has had to affirm that the right to live with dignity cannot be denied to anyone and since rights have no borders, no one can remain excluded, regardless of where they are born.

**NEW NATIONAL RESTRICTIONS** are in effect for a month until Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. This means that St Catherine's is now closed for the celebration of Mass, Baptisms and Weddings. However, it is open for private prayer on Tuesdays at 9.15am until 10.15am. Funerals are exempt from the restrictions and are able to take place in church with a maximum number of 30 people. Fr David will celebrate Mass via Zoom on Thursdays at 9.15am and Sundays at 10am. Children's Liturgy via Zoom continues on Sundays at 11.15am. Those who are already on the Online Mass mailing list will continue to be sent the link each week together with the recording of Sunday Mass shortly after Mass has been celebrated. **GUIDANCE FOR PRIVATE PRAYER:** In line with governmental and diocesan guidelines we have the following safety measures in place:

- on arrival a steward will ask you to sanitise your hands and guide you to a suitable bench depending on whether you have come as part of a household or as an individual observing at all times a 2m social distancing procedure. A maximum of ten people are permitted in the church at any time during private prayer.
- everyone must wear face coverings; please bring your own covering with you. There will be some available if you do not have one.
- individual private prayer is for 15 minutes duration. Please support the stewards by keeping to the guidance. You may be politely reminded when your 15 minutes has elapsed.
- you can choose whether you would like to leave your name and contact details as part of the NHS Test and Trace service. You can either use the QR code on the posters which can be found at the entrance, or you will find a card and pen in your bench to do so. This information will be kept by the Parish for 21 days and destroyed after this time.
- Thank you very much for your co-operation and understanding.
