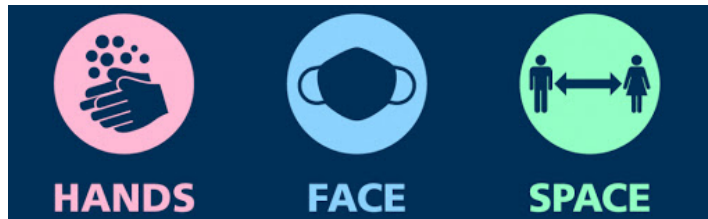


CHILDREN'S LITURGY GROUP is taking a break over the Easter Holidays.

GUIDANCE FOR THE CELEBRATION OF MASS: In line with governmental and diocesan guidelines we have the following safety measures in place:

- on arrival for Mass, a steward will ask you to sanitise your hands and guide you to a suitable bench depending on whether you have come as part of a household or as an individual observing at all times the minimum 1m+ social distancing procedures.
- Please dispense your own hand sanitiser from the table in the porch.
- everyone must wear face coverings; please bring your own covering with you and **ensure it is worn correctly over your nose and mouth**. There will be some available if you do not have one.
- **please remain in your bench at the end of Mass and wait to be asked to leave by a steward. This ensures safe distancing on exiting the church.**
- you can choose whether you would like to leave your name and contact details as part of the NHS Test and Trace service. You will find a card and pen in your bench to do so. This information will be kept by the Parish for 21 days and destroyed after this time. Please place your completed card and pen in the designated baskets at the end of Mass.
- booking is not required.
- Please sit only where stewards direct you to and wait for a steward to guide you to an exit at the end of Mass. This ensures a safe distancing on exiting the church.
- Please do not mingle after Mass. Please leave the premises promptly.
- **Please bear in mind that the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days remains suspended.**
