FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: During the Easter season a major concern in the Sunday Scripture readings was how the movement begun by the earthly Jesus might continue after his death, resurrection and ascension. These readings showed that we can have a personal relationship with the glorious risen Christ. From that relationship flows the possibility of knowing and loving God and one another in new and more profound ways, radiating the peace of Christ, working for unity with others and listening to and cooperating with the Holy Spirit. A major element in this process is the Eucharist as the outward sign of the ongoing presence of God and the risen Christ among us. The passage from Luke 9 recounts the narrative of Jesus's multiplication of five loaves of bread and two fish in order to feed a large crowd. The way in which Luke tells this story links Jesus's action with the Last Supper and the early Church's celebration of the Eucharist. In Luke's Gospel it is one of a series of meals that Jesus celebrates (often with unlikely persons) and serves as an enacted parable of his hopes for the eternal banquet to be celebrated in the kingdom of God.
